Welcome

Set in 8 acres of fields and woods within Dartmoor National Park with direct access on to the Wray Valley Trail, between Lustleigh and Moretonhampstead there is plenty of space to relax, enjoy and explore. Walk your dog, take your bike on the cycle way or just relax in the grounds and listen to the birdsong. Imagine sitting around the campfire, toasting marshmallows, gazing at the stars and listening to the owls.

Tent-only camping on 5 large pitches in our hay meadow and also nearly wild style camping on our water meadow and in the woods. We are family friendly and children love the freedom of playing in our woods and the river which runs through the grounds.

Travel by public transport

- You can get to Wray Valley Camping by bus.
- The nearest bus stop is at Wray Barton The bus stop is 0.5 miles / 0.8 km from Wray Valley Camping.
- Foot access from Wray Barton is on the Wray Valley Trail over a narrow footbridge unsuitable for wheelchairs. There is no pavement on the A382 from Wray Barton and the road is narrow in places.

Travel by taxi

- You can get a taxi with Dartmoor Taxi by calling 07496968484. The taxi company has a wheelchair accessible vehicle.
- You can get a taxi with Bovey Cars by calling 07739508554.
- We have a transfer service for visitors. We are happy to pick up visitors arriving at Moretonhampstead or Bovey Tracey by public transport given advance notice

Parking

- We have a car park. The parking is less than 50 metres from the main entrance. Parking is free.
- There is a drop-off point at the main entrance. The drop-off point does not have a dropped kerb.
- From the car park to the entrance, there is level access. The path is sloped.
- The route is 5000mm wide, or more.
- Entrance to the parking area and Hay Meadow field is via a steeply sloping driveway. The car parking area is also sloping

- From the street to the main entrance, there is level access.
- The path is 4000mm wide, or more.
- The path is sloped.



Main entrance

- The main entrance has level access.
- The main entrance is a sloping access from the A382 to a field gate leading directly into the parking area.

- Some parts of the venue have low lighting.



Site facilities

- The direction of transfer onto the toilet is to the right.
- The taps are lever operated. There is space under the basin, with no pedestal or boxing.

Public toilet

Tree Bog Compost Toilet

- From the main entrance to the public toilet, there is level access. The direction of transfer onto the toilet is to the front only.
- The toilet seat is on a bench as shown in the picture of the interior

Campers Kitchen

- From the main entrance to this area, there is level access.
- Campers kitchen has washing up area, microwave and kettle

Getting around outside

Gardens and Grounds

- From the main entrance to the gardens, there is level access.
- The route is sloped.
- The campsite is in the grounds.

Riverside walk and woodlands

- From the main entrance to this area, there is level access.
- This area is level but the surface is uneven underfoot
